FIRST EXTRAORDINARY CALL OF THE DIATRRAIN (COMP) PROGRAM

DIATRRAIN (DIAbetes Trans-national Research Advancement for Investigators) is a mobility program promoted by the Spanish Biomedical Research Centre in Diabetes and Associated Metabolic Disorders (CIBERDEM) and co-financed by the FP7-People-2010-COFUND program of the European Commission through the Grant Agreement No. 267248.

The first extraordinary call of DIATRRAIN was addressed to all the Postdoctoral researchers working at CIBERDEM and offered one fellowship for a research stay at a foreign centre.
